

Parole of Honor,

We hereby pledge our word of Honor, after our release from the Confederate States Military Prison at Tuscaloosa, Ala. to proceed forthwith to Norfolk, Va. by the way of Petersburg and City Point and report ourselves to Gen. Huger. And that we will not under any circumstances, take up arms against, or do anything to the prejudice of the Confederate States, or any State composing said Confederacy, or the people thereof, until regularly Exchanged, under such penalty as the Confederate States shall see proper to inflict, for a violation of this Parole, if taken hereafter. Transportation being furnished for this purpose.
